路桂軍醫師身兼清華大學附屬北京清華長庚醫院疼痛科主任,安寧療護團隊負責人及廈門 長庚醫院疼痛科主任等職,主要從事疼痛醫學相關疾病的診療工作和臨終患者的安寧療護。診療 過程中重視患者就醫體驗,關注患者生活質量,倡導醫學人文與醫療科技並重。"要讓患者有尊 嚴的走完最後一程"是路桂軍深耕安寧療護領域的初心和使命,他認為生命教育任重道遠,如何 平息痛苦,讓愛和關懷照亮歸途是醫生對生命最終的守護與敬重。

在2021年3月,路桂軍醫師在北京為自己辦了一場葬禮,他甚至自己躺進棺材裡體會逝者的感受, 引起媒體大篇幅報導與關注。參加過自己的葬禮後,他更加能感同身受,患者即使在醫學角度上 沒救了,他依然有疼痛需要緩解,有遺憾需要彌補,這就是安寧療護的重要任務。
